**4. Police Report.**

## 5. Correspondence and Action Points.

Letter 1. CCllr Pilmer reported that a letter relating to Speeding vehicles was received from a Company and that the GCC reply was that the matter is for Police Scotland.

Letter 2. CCllr Ponton confirmed that correspondence from PKC Cllr Roberston concerning Greenbank Road is still ongoing. Continuation of dialogue with actions, between various parties, will continue to be the case until the matter is resolved.

## 6. Meetings – Virtual and Public.

CCllr Smart reported that he had attended a Kinross-shire Partnership meeting prior to the close of 2025. Matters recorded were as follows.

Walking routes with the potential of an PKC “App” to assist walkers.

Road Safety Report on the 20mph Speed Limit implementation throughout Kinross-shire and the Mawcarse Junction regarding safety improvements e.g. speed limits and signage improvements all to be reviewed by PKC Roads Department.

Grow wild diversity throughout Kinross-shire and maps of areas of implementation.

Investment funds for Wellbeing by the Scottish Government for local Community Action Plans (need to look at this further with ideas - CCllr Ibbotson) and what could be possible.

Localised Development Plan (LDP) for Glenfarg Ward not submitted in 2025 pending nil areas identified for buildings of a private/commercial venture. CCllr Ponton stated that the original document requires to be updated. Source the original document for the next Business Meeting to explore any possible updates. *Action by CCllr Ponton, CCllr Christie, CCllr Pilmer*

## 8. Finance Report

CCllr Pilmer stated that in the absence of the Treasurer and a report for the evening that the matter is to be continued forward to the next Business Meeting. The GCC Final Accounts are to be filed with PKC after and pending an independent audit once all paperwork has been forwarded for the review.

## 9. AOCB

Speedwatch. CCllr Ponton raised the matter relating to the Community Speedwatch campaign and, whilst it hasn't commenced, it is hoped that an overall community campaign will commence during 2026. CCllr Ponton is to speak with the Chair of Milnathort Community Council regarding the matter.

Copperfields. CCllr Smart reported that a letter had been received by the owners of properties in the Copperfield' private housing development notifying them that the roads and pavements had now been handed over to PKC. CCllr Smart reported further that several points require implementation such as: the 20mph limit requires to be extended into the housing development. Dog waste bins were required. Clarification with PKC to establish what grounds they will now maintain and two further topics concerning drainage and trees. *Action CCllr Smart*

Pavement on Duncrievie Road sited on the left hand side of the road approximately 50m past the entrance to Elm Row and Birch Lane leading towards Wallace Park. A general discussion took place about the partial collapse of the pavement into the rear boundary area of one of the private residences situated on Duncrievie Road. The matter was believed to have been reported to PKC previously during 2025 although to date no rectification work has taken place. PKC Cllr Watters to pass notification about this matter to the relevant PKC department. *Action PKC*

The Glenfarg Hotel. A discussion took place regarding the current state of the Hotel and who the current owners were believed to be. CCllr Ibbotson offered to write to the point of contact on behalf of the GCC again. *Action CCllr Ibbotson*
