Perth & Kinross Childcare Initiative

Community Council

The following is an extract from the minutes of the Community Council meeting held on 7 September, at which ten members of the public were present.

PLANNING FOR THE SOUTH SIDE OF GLENFARG Mr. Lochhead (Planning Officer) outlined the procedure with regard to the proposed Stephen's housing development on the south side of the village. He stated that Perth & Kinross Council have decided to retain the site beside Wallace Park for housing development purposes, while accepting the Community Council's recommendation to include alternative housing provision e.g. housing for the elderly, smaller affordable homes etc. It was also agreed that after public consultation, a village boundary would exist around Duncricvie.

A document reflecting these proposals is due to be published within the next four weeks. From the date of publication, the public have six weeks to lodge objections, which are heard at a public enquiry. An independent Reporter prepares a report on all objections. Recommendations made by the Reporter are not binding on the Council, but are rarely opposed. Prior to the final approval of the planning application, the proposal becomes the subject of a "Brief" to be prepared jointly by the landowner, the Community Council and the public.

Mr. Lochhead has liased with Stephens on the issue of a footpath link between Glenfarg and Duncricvie, via a woodland walk. He presented a drawing of the proposed walk, and the public noted that it did not extend far into Duncricvie. Mr.

Lochhead suggested that the provision of the additional path would at least be a smaller target for the village to meet. Mr. Lochhead agreed that it was possible to pursue the footpath link by identifying the link as a priority under the Draft Countryside Strategy Document, recently received by the Community Council.

Concern was expressed that the number of homes proposed had risen from 12 to 40. Mr. Lochhead stated that no more than 50 would be accepted, but that the Health and Safety Executive could decide to reduce this number. Mr. Lochhead also responded to concern that Stephens may build more homes in the area, and denied that this would happen. Stephens would be required to upgrade the main sewage system.

ROADS Work on the roads in Glenfarg has already commenced. It was agreed, however, that the Community Council should continue to write to Perth & Kinross council monthly regarding any road issues. Members of the public should draw the attention of Councillors to any particular problems, or report them directly on 0800 232323.

CONDUCT OF FOOTBALL PLAYERS IN WALLACE PARK A number of members of the public have expressed concern about the foul language used by football players in Wallace Park. It was also noted that players were unable to use the toilet facilities, following their closure. It was agreed that a warning letter be sent to the Football Club, asking them to take responsibility for players' behaviour. Cllr. Law suggested that the

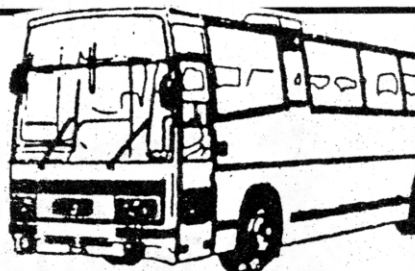

football or Tennis Club assume responsibility for the Park toilet facilities. Letters would be sent to the clubs concerning this.

BINN FARM LORRIES Lorries are driving through Glenfarg from the south, contrary to the conditions of planning consent. Letters to be sent to Binn Farm and the Planning Dept. regarding this.

OVERGROWN HEDGES Once again many hedges are overgrown, causing obstruction to pedestrians and drivers. Generally this is the responsibility of landowners, but where there is a traffic hazard, the Council should be contacted.

LAND AT REAR OF HALL It was approved in principle that the Community Council should fund the cost of fencing and gates to this area, but estimates would be required.

LIBRARY CLOCK It was agreed that restoration of this clock was a worthwhile but costly project.

Further discussion would take place with the present occupier of the premises.

AOCB

A villager expressed concern that there was mention of a golf practice area in the park, but not of a dog-walking area.

A villager expressed concern over the possible disposal of toxic waste at Binn Farm as suggested by a Friends of the Earth article. Cllr. Law agreed to look into this.

Concern was expressed about the high levels of chlorine in the water, making it unacceptable for drinking. It was also reported that algae is causing a problem in the reservoir, and this also causes an unpleasant taste.
